

Generative AI (GenAI) tools are expected to change many existing economic and social processes. It is often framed as a force for opportunity in India: driving innovation, bridging linguistic and digital divides, and enhancing public service delivery. When implemented responsibly, GenAI in India could foster meaningful progress and advancement, supported by the country's robust digital infrastructure, abundant technological talent, and vast, connected population.

However, alongside these opportunities lie profound risks. GenAI systems have demonstrated a troubling capacity to reproduce and amplify social biases, entrench sycophancy and drain environmental resources. If deeply integrated into our social infrastructure without adequate guardrails, these tools could inadvertently reinforce existing inequities, further marginalising communities already on the fringes of technological progress.

While some immediate impacts may be apparent, the long-term implications are not. Failing to anticipate future consequences early on may hurtle us toward harmful technology and policy lock-ins.

Human in the Loop, a project by the Digital Futures Lab (DFL) in partnership with Quicksand Design Studio and supported by Rohini Nilekani Philanthropies (RNP), aims to explore the complexities surrounding the unintended and long-term impacts of GenAl.

Grounded in participatory foresight methods and creative storytelling, this project brings together diverse voices and perspectives. Through workshops, expert consultations, and public engagement, we engaged deeply with those who both build and experience the impacts of these technologies.

We assembled a group of leading experts and practitioners to systematically identify the first-, second-, and third-order consequences of the dominant use cases of GenAl in the critical social sector. To facilitate this exercise, we scanned popular media and academic articles for emerging signals of change and used a Futures Wheel. This structured approach helped us connect short-term technological developments with broader, long-term societal impacts.

Foresight, however, is not solely the domain of experts; it must include public participation. To conclude this project, we issued a nationwide public call inviting people to submit short stories expressing their hopes and concerns about the future of GenAl in India.

The stories in Human in the Loop, that traverse various domains and themes such as agriculture, healthcare, judiciary, creative industries, environmental resources, Al companionship, and agentic Al, are not just speculative fiction; they are invitations to time-travel to the worlds we might be living in very soon. In an age where technology is evolving faster than our ethical, social, and ecological frameworks can keep pace, these narratives serve as guideposts of what could become of us. We hope that these stories cultivate a longing for futures that centre human dignity, planetary care, and equitable technological progress. Without such glimpses, we risk hurtling toward futures that do not serve us - futures more extractive, isolating, and unjust than the present.


